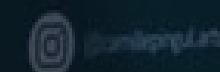

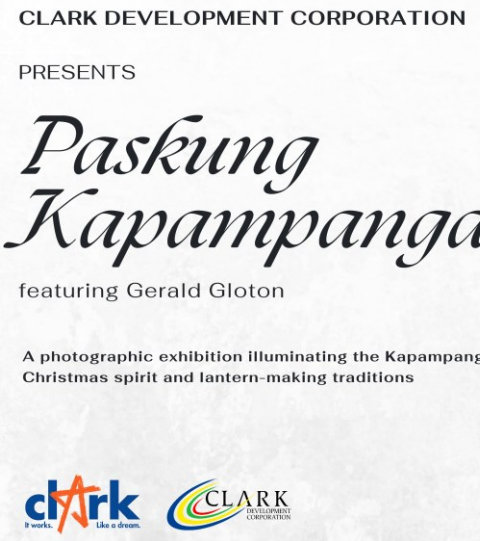

A diorama is a replica of a scene, typically a three-dimensional model either full-sized or miniature. Sometimes it is enclosed in a glass showcase for a museum. Dioramas are often built by hobbyists as part of related hobbies such as Heritage houses modeling, miniature figure modeling, or aircraft modeling.

Tipos del Pais. During the 19th century, secular subject matter in painting the Philippines increased extensively. With more tourists, ilustrados and foreigners demanding souvenirs and decorations from the country, Tipos del Pais developed in painting. Damian Domingo was the most popular artist who worked in this style.

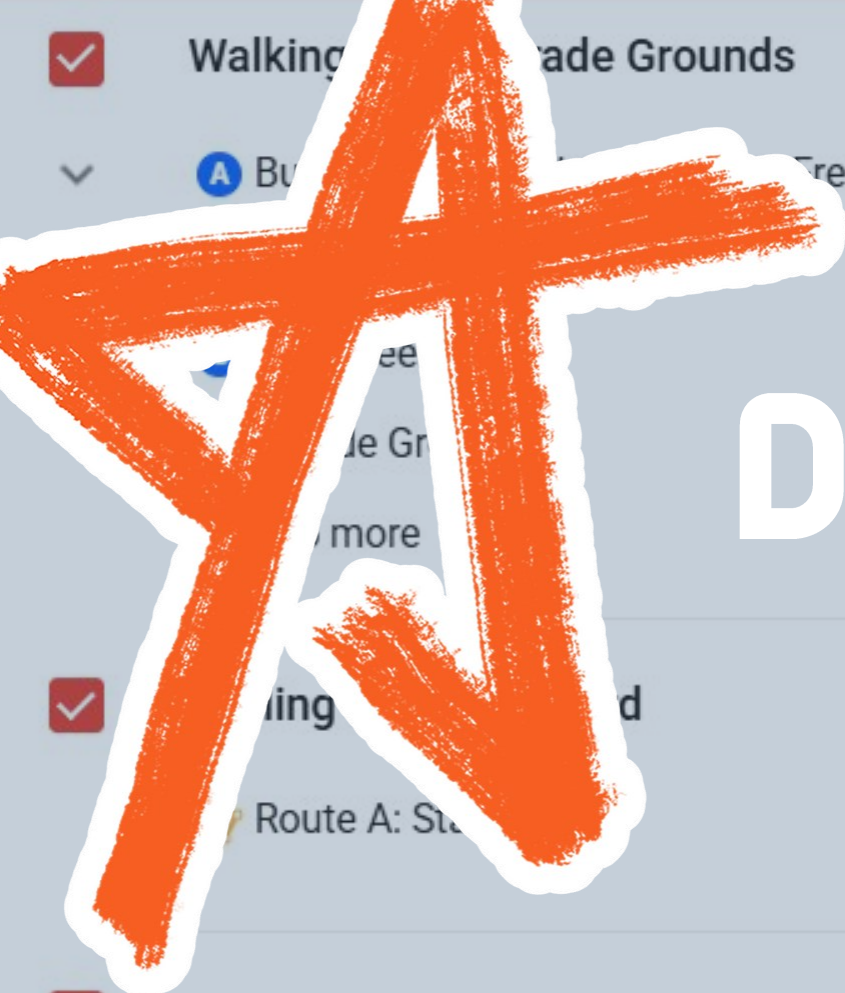
